Sexual Exploitation

We are running **Chelsea's Choice** in schools in Gloucestershire because we want you to be safe and happy and able to recognise unhealthy, exploitative relationships.

Sexual exploitation is difficult to explain and everyone's situation is different. It can mean that someone may be forcing or coercing you to have sexual contact with them, or other people. It could also be an adult taking advantage of a situation you are in to get you to have sex with them. This could include sexual contact in return for money, alcohol, somewhere to stay, gifts or favours.

If this is happening to you, it is definitely not your fault!

Have you been affected by the performance?
Are you worried about sexual exploitation?
Do you think that you or someone else might be at risk?

If your answer to any of the above questions is Yes, you need to ask
for help - turn over for what



to do next.

What to do next

- Speak to someone at school. At Severn Vale school speak to your Year Team Leader, Deputy Year Team Leader, Tutor, Mrs Ireland, Mr Nichols or any other member of staff. You can also speak to the school counselor - they will get you the support you need
- Phone the GDVSAP support line on: 01452 500115 (10am - 4pm, Monday to Fridays) and a worker will help you to make sense of what's going on and give you advice. We will not share what you tell us without your permission - unless we believe that you or someone else is in real danger. We want and must keep you safe.
